Minutes - Deene & Deenethorpe Parish Council Meeting Thursday 14th September 2017 in Deene village hall at 7.30pm

Councillors Present	Stuart Barratt, Mark Coombs, Brian Gretton (Chair), John Goodfellow, Graham Holding and Chris Upton
Also Present	1 member of the public and Sue Cook (Clerk)

647. Apologies for absence were received from Mr. John Marchant and accepted.
648. Cllr Coombs declared pecuniary and personal interests on all matters relating to Deene Estate's planning and development matters. There is a permanent dispensation in place as per minute 450.
649. With no other members of the public present the public time was handed over to Mr. Daniel Beyzade, who lives in Deenethorpe and will become the Parish Councils contact for the Gigaclear project. Mr. Beyzade confirmed that Gigaclear have won the contract for the 3rd phase of Superfast Broadband and will install it in both Deene and Deenethorpe by December 2018. The only problem that Mr. Beyzade foresees is that Gigaclear will not install the broadband along the un-adopted road in Deenethorpe, it was highlighted to Mr. Beyzade that this is a separate item on the agenda. Mr. Beyzade doesn't think that Lodge Farm will be included in the project as it has a Corby STD code and is quite a way from Deenethorpe. Cllr Coombs suggested that it should be included when Broadband is installed at Tresham Village.
650. The minutes of the meeting held on 13th July 2017 were approved and signed as a true record by Cllr Gretton
651. No new plans have been received.
652. Cllr Gretton informed the meeting that there had been a meeting on Wednesday 13th between himself, Cllr Coombs, the Clerk, and representatives from Anglian Water, NCC Highways and Persimmon Homes to try to resolve both the Sewage Problems and Road Adoption in Deenethorpe.
The air pump in the Lagoon has broken down and AW are sending tankers in daily to remove the waste at their expense. One solution is to build a new Lagoon.

Persimmon Homes are looking at a solution for the drainage problem and have been out on site today. Once this has been resolved NCC Highways will adopt the road without the 12 months maintenance charge to Persimmon Homes.
653. Cllr Coombs agreed to look into thinning some of the trees and shrubs on the Village Green in Deenethorpe as it is dark and oppressive. The area is not managed and is out of control. Once this has been carried out it will widen

the road slightly and hopefully will stop large farm vehicles damaging the hedges in Deenethorpe.

654. Highways Issues:
- a) Damaged hedges within Deenethorpe Village, covered in item 653.
 - b) After consulting with ENC and the Post Office, the Post Office would re-number all the properties in Deenethorpe prior to the Street Signs being produced which in turn would mean that the residents would have to change their deeds to show the new property number and street name, along with re-registering the property with the Land Registry. New maps would have to be produced and Data issued to the Emergency Services. At this point the Parish Council agreed not to proceed with this.
 - c) Cllr Gretton has spoken to Sarah Barnwell about installing a One Way System in Deenethorpe, with Osier Bed Lane being made as an exit road only.
655. Mr. Marchant has issued Draft Parish Plans to the Councillors and it was agreed that the Councillors should review the plan for a week prior to it being published on the Web-site.
656. Cllr Holding informed that at the meeting that on September 26th the Master Plan for Tresham Village will be presented to the Board and hopefully by October 23rd the Master Plan will be available for Public Consultation. Cllr Holding also informed the meeting that he reminds the Board at every meeting about the impact on the environment that this project will have.
657. The Website is now up and running, the Clerk confirmed that several pages have been re-named to include a page for The Parish Plan, a page for Tresham Village and one for the Village Hall. The Clerk also confirmed that she is showing Cllr Goodfellow how to upload documents as a backup.
658. The Clerk confirmed that both she and Cllr Goodfellow had completed an application for National Lottery Funding for the two Defibrillators, however the National Lottery have rejected the form as they have recently changed the form. The Clerk has completed the new form and it is currently waiting to be read by Su Davies at ENC before submitting to the National Lottery. Cllr Goodfellow read out a list of what will be supplied with Defibrillators.
659. Cllr Coombs confirmed that he personally had not received any complaints about the Illusive Festival, although 3 complaints have been received from Priors Hall. The Sound Management Team did exactly as was agreed. The organisers did tighten up on entry to the site which in turn meant that some vehicles were left parked outside residents houses in Deene but these were towed away. Cllr Upton had agreed to be contacted on the Saturday morning with regard to the noise from the previous night however no one had called but someone had tried to enter his garden by the back gate. There is a meeting at ENC on October 4th to review the Festival and Cllr Barratt agreed to attend to

represent the Parish Council. It is hoped that the results from the sound readings will be available for that meeting.

660. Financial Matters
